provided below. The watering schedule is based on the last number of customers' street addresses. No outdoor watering between

10AM – 6PM and no watering on Wednesday's

- If the last number of your address ends in an even number your watering days are:
 Sunday, Tuesday and Friday
- If the last number of your address ends in an odd number your watering days are:
 Monday, Thursday and Saturday
- Exceptions to this may be made for District and City of Steamboat Springs approved management purposes.

Tips for summer irrigating:

- MWW has free irrigation timers that can connect to your hose, visit the Fish Creek office to pick one up
- Turn off your sprinkler system if it has rained

Moltz Construction and Triangle Electric and have started preliminary construction which includes working on the electrical components and preparation for the new Orthophosphate system which will utilize Lime and CO2.

Ski Time Square Turnaround Project

This project includes the removal, upsize, and replacement of the VCP sewer main with a new PVC main and water main improvements under Ski Time Square Drive near Kutuk Condo's. The project will be completed in partnership with the City's Turnaround Project. Native Construction will mobilize to the site the Monday after the Resort closes to start the project.

Snow Depth and Snow Water Equivalent (SWE) as of 3/26/24

Colorado snowpack was 110% of Average. The snow depth at the SNOTEL tower site (near the top of Buffalo Pass) was 48 inches and the SWE was 13.9 inches. This snow fills Fish Creek and Long Lake reservoirs which gives us the raw water supply for the Fish Creek Treatment Plant. As of 3/7/24 the Fish Creek Reservoir was 41.5% full.

2025 Projects Outlook

Planning, engineering, and design for the Sewage Lift Station and Booster 1 Water Distribution Station improvement projects are underway with upgrades expected to start in 2025.
